## Our Specialist Approaches and Interventions

Alongside a broad and balanced curriculum, we provide specialist approaches to teaching children with Autism such as TEACCH (Treatment and Education of Communication Handicapped Children), SCERTS (Social Communication Emotional Regulation and Transactional Supports) and PECS (Picture Exchange Communication) in order for them to access the curriculum. We offer a total communication environment for our students with Autism, which may include signs, symbols and some augmentative communication equipment.

We offer our students with complex needs / sensory impairment a sensory enriched curriculum and access to additional therapies such as Rebound Therapy and Hydro Therapy.

We follow 'Nurturing Principles' as a whole school and in addition offer students who are identified by Boxall profiling, specialist interventions, including opportunities to access our Nurture Group. We were awarded a 'Learning Excellence Best Practice Award' in 2011 for this work.

## Religious Education

The school tries to ensure that all children grow up with an awareness of the cultural diversity of our society. This includes knowledge and understanding of different cultures and religions, in our country and across the world. The general ethos of school is based on traditional Christian values and Religious Education is taught throughout the school. We also celebrate important religious festivals such as Eid and Diwali.
