## Programmes Of Support

### Programme One- £30

Half day placement in Broadfield Specialist School includes 'on the job' TA/Teacher training and advice.

### Programme Two- £125

Teacher to observe pupil and give verbal feedback to school staff (approx. 90 minutes in school).

### Programme Three- £200

Teacher to observe pupil and write a report (approx. 90 minutes in school plus written report).

### Programme Four- £300

Half day package- Teacher in school for three hours including a written report if required. This is delivered in a single morning or afternoon.

### Programme Five- £200

Whole staff training twilight (approx. 1-2 hours).

### Programme Six- £75

Regular hourly session for teacher to work with individual/small group of pupils to meet specific SEN.
