



Pupil Premium Grant

In **2018/19** the total funding allocation for PPG was **£55,627**

In 2018/19 we had: 48 students registered as FSM, 3 students registered as CLA, and no students registered as service children. We deployed a Higher Level Teaching Assistant (HLTA) to plan the provision for all students eligible for PPG. Outcomes were monitored and evaluated via BSquared and CASPA, and all of the students made measurable progress in key subjects over the academic year, as shown below:
