Programmes of Support

Programme One- £70

Half day placement in Broadfield
Specialist School includes 'on the job'
TA/Teacher training and advice.

Programme Two- £150

Teacher to observe pupil and give verbal
feedback to school staff (approx. 90 minutes
in school).

Programme Three- £225

Teacher to observe pupil and provide a
written report (approx. 90 minutes in school
plus written report).

Programme Four- £300

Half day package- Teacher in school for three
hours including a written report if required.
This is delivered in a single morning or
afternoon.

Programme Five- £400

Whole staff training / twilight
(approx. 1-2 hours).

Programme Six- £100

Regular hourly session for teacher to work
with individual/small group of pupils to
provide intervention or meet their needs.
