School Uniform Policy

The policy of students wearing the specified school uniform has the full support of the Governors, staff and parents. If students fail to follow the school uniform policy, we will endeavour to issue loaned school uniform items from school.

Year 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 (Key Stages 3 & 4):

- V-neck navy blue jumper/cardigan, contrasting red feature with Broadfield School badge OR navy blue sweatshirt with Broadfield School badge is permissible for some students with specific needs
- Pale blue polo shirt or pale blue cotton school shirt/blouse
- Navy blue tie with Broadfield School badge (optional)
- Navy blue blazer with Broadfield School badge (optional)
- Grey trousers or knee length tailored shorts/ Grey skirt or Broadfield School checked skirt
- Plain black, flat, leather shoes (no boots, trainers, logos or canvas)
- Black, grey or navy blue ankle socks/knee socks or plain black, grey or navy blue tights

Year 12, 13, 14 / Post-16 College (Key Stage 5):

- Black blazer (optional)
- Black school trousers or skirt
- Black V-neck jumper or cardigan
- White polo shirt or white cotton school shirt/blouse
- Plain school socks or tights
- Black school shoes
- Black tie with Broadfield School logo

PE Kit - ALL students

- Blue & red short-sleeved PE top and matching shorts with Broadfield School logo
- Blue & red Quarter zip long-sleeved tracksuit top with Broadfield School logo (optional)
- Navy Blue track suit pants for colder weather (optional)
- Trainers
- PE bag, with drawstring, to keep in school

Stationery – ALL students

- Pencil case with pens, pencils, ruler, eraser and sharpener
- Scientific calculator (if needed, can be purchased from school via ParentPay)

Please note

- Skirts should be between mid-thigh and knee length
- Girls may wear leggings under PE shorts, if required
- Both boys' and girls' trousers must not be jean style. Skinny/drain pipe trousers or trousers with studs on the back pockets are in breach of the school policy
- Jewellery, if worn, is limited to one small ring and one pair of studs (in the lobe of each ear). No other piercings are allowed
- Make-up, if worn, should be subtle and minimal
- Hairstyles should be natural hair colour, suitable length (number 2 & above), and longer hair tied back with black, blue, grey, red or white hair bobbles or bands
- Coats, Hoodies, Scarves and Hats are not to be worn in the school building
- All items should be named so that they may be returned to the rightful owner if misplaced
